#### **Selection Committee outcome**



After match registration closed at the end of January, the Selection Committee (President Bill Kent, Captain David Woodroffe, Vice-captain Peter Brickell and Secretary Nigel Mobbs) met in February and decided the teams for our matches. We used a random draw when a match was oversubscribed and made one or two adjustments to give everyone at least one of their first two selections. The resulting Team Lists have been <u>published on our website</u> with those unlucky in the draw being considered First Reserves for the matches where they missed out

This year we have 160 places to fill in our intercounty matches, of which 10 will be taken by the Captain or Vice-captain and 5 are allotted to the current captains of our home courses, leaving 145 places for the members. We had 65 members register for matches. These numbers explain why the majority of registered members are selected for two matches.
